German-Turkish Partnership for the Vocational Qualification of Syrian refugees and disadvantaged Turkish groups in Turkey.

From January 2016 until November 2022, sequa has been implementing the German-Turkish Partnership for Vocational Qualification (TAMEB). The project supported Turkey in overcoming the consequences of the crisis in Syria in the frame of which Turkey has accepted 3,7 Mio refugees. In cooperation with partners from the German business community and Turkish partners, sequa implemented measures for vocational qualification and social integration for economic and social stabilization in host communities.

Approach



sequa cooperated closely with institutions of the German private sector with strong competences in the area of vocational education. Each German Partner organized vocational education measures tailored for the target group in various sectors in close cooperation with Turkish institutions. These vocational education trainings were complemented by prior Turkish language and social integration courses. Furthermore, job coaches were set to support the program participants to facilitate their integration into the labor market. The objective of TAMEB had been aligned with the overall cooperation agreement between the Turkish and German government for a joint management of the Syrian refugee crisis in Turkey.

Effect



- 7.450 Syrian refugees were certified to a Turkish A2 level.
- 4.755 enrolled in the social integration courses developed by the project.
- 6.977 received a state certificate after successful completion of the VET trainings:
 - of which 56% were Syrians
 - of which 63% were women
- 127 VET Trainers and Job Coaches were trained within the framework of the ToT measures.
- By the end of the project, 2.761 (40%) of the certified graduates had taken up employment, were self-employed or had completed an internship. Of these, 44% were women.
- 2.931 graduates benefited from entrepreneurship and digital marketing trainings.
